This statement supplements and continues similar formal statements and declarations that have been deposited every six years with Calderdale Metropolitan Borough Council from the 14th December 1993 to date. This was to afford continuing protection to the said land. The last deposit prior to the filing of this Statement was made on the 1st November 2005.
- 6. I make this Statement for the purposes of Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980.
