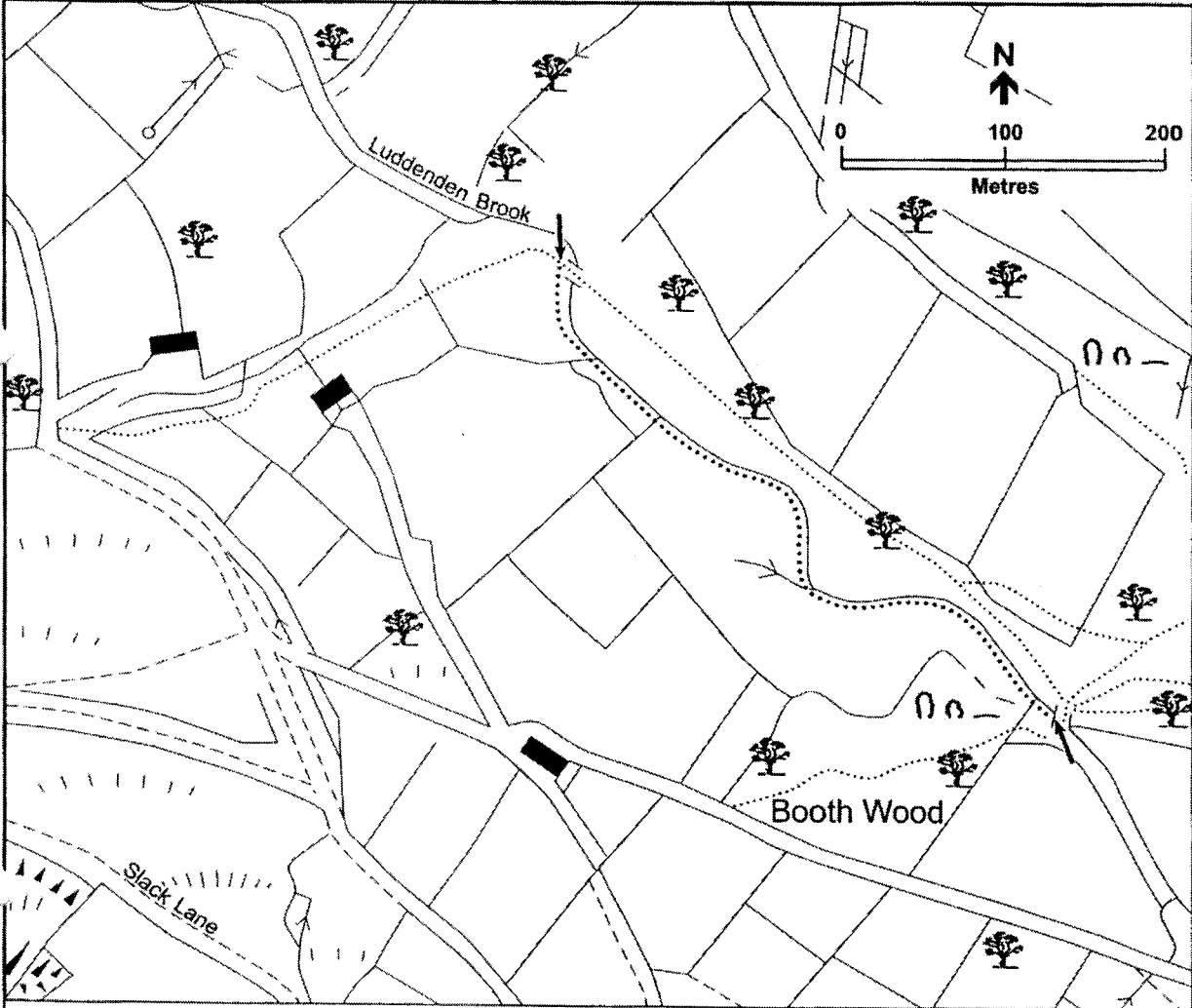

CONSERVATION WALKS
