

# ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014, S59

## THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE

### The Dogs on Leads (Calderdale) Order 2022

The Borough Council of Calderdale (in this Order called “the Authority”) hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order comes into force at 00:01 hours on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
2. The Authority is satisfied that the following activities are taking place within the restricted area:
  - incidents and concerns from the public arising from irresponsible dog ownership and poor dog control
3. The Authority is further satisfied that the activities referred to in paragraph 2 above are having or are likely to have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality and it therefore makes a Public Spaces Protection Order, the terms of which are explained below.

#### Restricted Area

4. Unless otherwise stated, the prohibitions and requirements detailed below shall apply at all times of the day and all days of the week throughout any calendar year throughout the entirety of the restricted area outlined in the schedule.

#### Dogs on Lead Requirement

5. (1) All persons in charge of a dog are hereby required keep the dog on a lead of not more than six feet six inches (6’6”) (or two (2) metres), unless –
  - (a) he has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so; or
  - (b) the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to his failing to do so.
- (2) For the purposes of this paragraph a person who habitually has a dog in his possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog.

#### Penalty

6. If a person is found to be in breach of paragraph 5 they shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
