INSTALLATION OF ZEBRA AND PUFFIN CROSSINGS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of Calderdale in exercise of its powers and having consulted with the Chief of Police under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a number of pedestrian crossings as part of a corridor improvement scheme.

The crossings are in various stages of design and construction, however this fact will have no bearing on the Council's assessment of any objections received. All such representations will be fully considered with an open mind and in a conscientious manner before a decision is made. Details of the crossings are as follows:-

A646 Burnley Road, Todmorden – Puffin Crossing

A Puffin crossing on Burnley Road, Todmorden, approximately 35 metres north east of its junction with Ridge Road.

The extents of the controlled area are:- from a point approximately 15 metres north east of its junction with Ridge Road for a distance of approximately 40 metres.

A646 Halifax Road, Todmorden – Puffin Crossing

A Puffin crossing on Halifax Road, Todmorden, approximately 35 metres east of its junction with Hey Street.

The extents of the controlled area are:- from a point approximately 12 metres east of its junction with Hey Street for a distance of approximately 40 metres.

A646 Halifax Road, Todmorden – Zebra Crossing

A Zebra crossing on Burnley Road, Todmorden, approximately 30 metres west of its junction with Bond Street.

The extents of the controlled area are:- from a point approximately 11 metres west of its junction with Bond Street for a distance of approximately 40 metres.
