Staff are trained to implement good health and safety practices, and have the required skills to carry out works competently and safely as a result of good ongoing training. They are provided with the correct Personal protective equipment (PPE) and clothing, and use plant and equipment which is regularly maintained in the interest of both safety and continuity of service.

All grounds care staff will carry Calderdale Council identification and wear clothing/ uniform marked by the Calderdale Council corporate logo. Our staff will comply with school requirements – booking in at the school office / reporting to the appropriate representative before commencing any work. Wherever possible, maintenance tasks will be undertaken when children are least likely to be present.

We will ensure the school grounds are kept presentable at all times, enhancing the appearance of the school to pupils, parents and visitors.
