

REGISTER OF MEMBERS' INTERESTS

1. The Head of Legal and Democratic Services, as the Monitoring Officer, will be responsible for the establishment and maintenance of the register of interests of Members and co-opted members (with voting rights) of the Council as required under Section 29 of the Localism Act 2012.
2. Members and co-opted members (with voting rights) are required, within 28 days of their election or appointment, to notify the Head of Legal and Democratic Services in writing of any disclosable pecuniary interest of a type specified in the relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012 and set out at Part 2 of the Code of Conduct for Members. (A copy of the Code is included in Part 5 of this Constitution.)
3. Members and co-opted members (with voting rights) must also give written notification of any change to their interests within 28 days of becoming aware of any change.
4. The written notifications will be recorded in a register which is available for public inspection at the offices of the Head of Legal and Democratic Services, Town Hall, Crossley Street, Halifax during normal office hours and published on the Council's website.
5. The above arrangements also apply in relation to the register of interests required to be maintained for interests notified by Town and Parish Councillors.
