NOTICE OF A PUBLIC INQUIRY

NOTICE is hereby given that a Public Inquiry in connection with the proposed Order mentioned below will be held by an Inspector appointed for this purpose by the Planning Inspectorate and will **begin at 10.00am on Tuesday 5 March 2024.** The Inquiry is scheduled for one day. The Public Inquiry will be held in the Council Chamber in the Halifax Town Hall, Crossley Street, Halifax, HX1 1UJ. The Inspector appointed to conduct the Public Inquiry is Kevin Ward.

The Order which was proposed by The Borough Council of Calderdale ("the Council") in a notice of proposals dated 15th day of December 2022 is **THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (HALIFAX) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2015 (VARIATION NO. *) ORDER 20****, the effect of which will be to introduce the following restrictions on roads in Northowram, Halifax:

- "no waiting at any time & no loading at any time" on a length of A6036 Bradford Road;
- "no waiting at any time" on lengths of A6036 Bradford Road and Oaklands Avenue; and
- "no waiting at any time & no loading Mon to Fri 8.15am 9.15am and 2.30pm 4.00pm" on a length of Towngate.

The Order would be made under Section 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
