

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (ON-STREET WAITING, LOADING AND PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2024 (VARIATION NO.2) ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that on 20 November 2024 the Borough Council of Calderdale ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 made the above Order, the effect of which is to introduce the following restrictions on roads in Northowram:

- "no waiting at any time & no loading at any time" on a length of A6036 Bradford Road;
- "no waiting at any time" on lengths of A6036 Bradford Road and Oaklands Avenue; and
- "no waiting at any time & no loading Mon to Fri 8.15am 9.15am and 2.30pm 4.00pm" on a length of Towngate.

The Order will come into force on 22 November 2024.

The Order was proposed on 15 December 2022 as the Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Halifax) (Consolidation) Order 2015 (Variation No. *) Order 20**. Since then, the Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Halifax) (Consolidation) Order 2015 has been revoked and consolidated into the Borough Council of Calderdale (On-Street Waiting, Loading and Parking) Consolidation Order 2024. The latter order consolidated and presented all on-street waiting, loading and parking restrictions in Calderdale hitherto 15 March 2024 on maps rather than in a text-based format. Accordingly, the name of the Order has changed from that publicised, as has the format in which its restrictions are presented. The substance of the restrictions remains as originally proposed on 15 December 2022, subject to minor modifications to reflect the new consolidated order and the extent of the length of Towngate being replaced by the new restriction. These modifications were recommended by an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State in a report dated 10 April 2024 following a public inquiry held on 5 March 2024.

Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, including the statement of reasons, plans showing the affected roads and the aforesaid Inspector's report, are available for inspection at Halifax Central Library, Halifax, HX1 1QG, from 10.00 am to 5.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays and 10.00 am to 4.00 pm on Saturdays. If you wish to question the validity of Order or of any of the provisions on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made (i.e. 20 November 2024) apply to the High Court for this purpose.
