Climate Action Partnership	IN2	Produce delivery plans for each theme group	2024	Work underway	In progress – while there is no explicit document outlining a plan, each group has a sense of direction, with clear plans for future meetings and prioritised areas of focus.
Climate Action Partnership	IN3	Develop climate adaptation plans	2026	Work underway	Calderdale Flood Action Plan has undergone a recent refresh in Autumn 2024. Calderdale Council has been developing service-level adaptation plans and piloting them with Public Health and Countryside services. Partnership members to provide individual updates.
Climate Action Partnership	IN4	Create a publicly accessible climate dashboard	2026	Work underway	Council officers within the Business Intelligence service and the Climate and Environment Team are working together to create a publicly accessible climate dashboard. This will be hosted on the Council's Dataworks website.
Climate Action Partnership and Vision	IN5	Regular reporting schedule	2024	On track	Chairs provide quarterly updates on the Climate Action Plan's progress at formal Partnership meetings. A reporting template has been created to record progress.
Vision	IN6	Increase number of sign-ups to climate e-newsletter	2023	On track	The newsletter list continues to grow. There were 571 subscribers in June 2024 and 646 by October 2024.
Vision	IN7	Implement a feedback mechanism to keep the public updated on the Partnership's progress	2026	On track	The Partnership's papers are available online. Formal meetings are available to watch after the event. Theme groups report progress to the Partnership and the first annual review is on track for publication in early 2025 with a supporting comms and engagement plan.
Collaborating	IN8	Identify funding and resources to deliver climate action	2026	Work underway	Council officers use GrantFinder to monitor funds available. Opportunities are communicated via the climate newsletter and to Theme Group members. There is not always a match between funds offered and local priorities.
Collaborating	IN9	Work in partnership to deliver climate action	2026	On track	The theme groups include a range of members representing voluntary, community, public service, corporate and SMEs working in partnership to deliver climate action.

All partners in Calderdale need to embed climate action into everyday decisions, such as what they buy and how they travel.
