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1. Primary Provision

Introduction

This section provides statistical information and projections for Primary School Provision to 2027/28.

The Authority is currently providing education for 17,674 pupils of primary school age. For the purpose of this document, Calderdale has been divided into its 15 planning areas. For each area, the outline of the planning area has been included and the primary schools within that area, historic and projected total pupil numbers for each school and historic and projected numbers for the normal year of entry (Reception).


The projected numbers are forecast using historical allocations and data provided by the Health Authority which is taken from the patients' register. The information provided includes the number of pre-school aged children and their dates of birth living in every postal sector of the Local Authority. The projections are not to be confused with parental preferencing, which is different to pupil demand.

New housing is not included within the figures, although it has been shown separately within the tables that show the total pupil numbers. Section 4 within this document provides information regarding housing data.

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




The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in the Greetland, Stainland and West Vale area and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.

Greetland, Stainland and West Vale Reception Pupil Intake



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in the Greetland, Stainland and West Vale area and the total PAN of schools in that area.





The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in Todmorden and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in the Todmorden and the total PAN of schools in that area.





The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in Rastrick and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in the Rastrick and the total PAN of schools in that area.







The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Brighouse and the total PAN of schools in that area.






The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in Lightcliffe and the overall number of places in schools in that area.








The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in Mytholmroyd and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Mytholmroyd and the total PAN of schools in that area.






The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in Luddenden and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Luddenden and the total PAN of schools in that area






The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in Elland and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Elland and the total PAN of schools in that area.





The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in Northowram and Shelf and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Northowram and Shelf and the total PAN of schools in that area.






The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in Sowerby Bridge and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Sowerby Bridge and the total PAN of schools in that area.






The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in the Ryburn Valley and Norland and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in the Ryburn Valley and Norland and the total PAN of schools in that area.







The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Hebden Bridge and the total PAN of schools in that area.






The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in Siddal and Southowram and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.




The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Siddal and Southowram and the total PAN of schools in that area.



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil numbers in North Halifax and the overall number of places available in schools in that area.



The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in North Halifax and the total PAN of schools in that area.








The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Central Halifax and the total PAN of schools in that area.



2. Secondary Provision

Introduction

This section provides statistical information and projections for Secondary School Provision to 2027/28.

The Authority is currently providing education for 14,525 pupils of secondary school age.

For the purpose of this document, Calderdale has been divided into its 4 Secondary planning areas. For each area, the outline of the planning area has been included and the secondary schools within that area, historic and projected total pupil numbers for each school and historic and projected numbers for the normal year of entry (Year 7).

The projected numbers are forecast using a pattern of allocations from each primary school which indicates what proportion of children in a given primary school are likely to go to a particular secondary school. This is done by taking a non-weighted average of the previous 3 years' allocations and applying it to the current year 6 population of each primary school and thus a number derived for each secondary school's Year 7.

The projected numbers for years 8 – 11 are based on the School Census.

New housing is not included within the figures, although it has been shown separately within the tables that show the total pupil numbers. Section 4 within this document provides information regarding housing data.






The above chart is a graphical representation of historical pupil numbers and projected pupil demand in Calderdale secondary schools (Years 7-11)




The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Calderdale secondary schools.






The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Calderdale secondary schools.






The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Calderdale secondary schools.




The above chart is a graphical representation of historical pupil numbers and projected pupil demand in Calderdale secondary schools (Years 7-11)




The above chart is a graphical representation of historical and projected pupil intake in Calderdale secondary schools.



5. Early Years Provision

- 5.1 Calderdale offers a wide range of early years and childcare provision through the private, independent, voluntary and maintained sectors for children and young people aged 0–19.
- 5.2 Within the private, voluntary and independent childcare sector, there are currently 325 registered childcare schemes, throughout Calderdale, for children aged 0-14 offering a range of options for families. Information is available at www.calderdalechildcare.org.uk
- 5.3 The Council's Cabinet currently commissions its Family Hubs from external providers. Family Hubs offer services for children and families. They offer early years education and childcare, health services and family support in your local community. For more information visit https://calderdalefamilyhubs.org.uk/
- 5.4 For children eligible for the government funded early years entitlements there is a good range of free early education provision across all sectors. There is currently a total of 155 private and voluntary settings offering early education, in addition to the maintained nursery and academy sector. - 5.5 The Local Authority has a statutory duty under the Childcare Acts 2006 and 2016 to assess and manage the childcare and early education market in Calderdale. The aim is to understand the demand for childcare across Calderdale and ensure that services match needs and are focused in the right geographical areas. 6. Special Educational Needs Provision

- 6.1 There are three special schools in Calderdale Authority: two generic primary schools (Highbury and Wood Bank) and one generic secondary school (Ravenscliffe High School). The Authority is committed to ensuring sufficient diversity and flexibility of provision to ensure that all pupils' individual needs are met. This diversity of provision is intended to promote and foster inclusion within the Council's education provision for all pupils.
- 6.2 The Authority actively promotes links between special and mainstream schools and encourages the inclusion of pupils with Special Educational Needs in mainstream schools where this best meets the learning needs of the individual pupil concerned. Proposals for school organisation must therefore have regard for the need to be sufficiently flexible to ensure that the individual needs of all pupils can be met through the Authority's planned provision of school places.
- 6.3 A small number of Calderdale pupils with Special Educational Needs are educated outside the Authority in non-maintained and independent special schools.
- 6.4 The Authority is committed to continue developing the diversity of its provision both in-school and in specialised provision to ensure that as many pupils as possible remain within the education system and are helped to overcome current barriers to effective learning.
