

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (STAFFORD ROAD) (HALIFAX) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Calderdale ('the Council') under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') made the above Order on 12 March 2025 Is, the effect of which is to reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the Borough Council of Calderdale (Stafford Road) (Halifax) Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 2023 ('The Experimental Order'). The Order will permanently continue in force the following restrictions that were introduced by the Experimental Order:

No motor vehicles shall proceed along the length of Stafford Road from its junction with the A629 Huddersfield Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 17 metres, at all times.

The Order comes into force on 14 March 2025. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order, including the plan showing the affected road and the statement of reasons for the Experimental Order, are available for inspection at Halifax Central Library, Halifax, HX1 1QG, from 10.00am to 5.30pm on Mondays to Fridays and 10.00am to 4.00pm on Saturdays. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made (i.e. from 12 March 2025), apply to the High Court for that purpose.
