

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (WAINSTALLS SCHOOL) (TREE LANE) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (ON-STREET WAITING, LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2024 (VARIATION NO.4) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Calderdale ('the Council') under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') made the above Orders on 30 April 2025 the effect of which is to reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the Borough Council of Calderdale (Wainstalls School) (Wainstalls Road and Tree Lane) Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 2023 ('The Experimental Order').

The Orders will permanently continue in force the following restrictions that were introduced by the Experimental Order:

- (a) The Borough Council of Calderdale (Wainstalls School) (Tree Lane) Traffic Regulation Order 2025 relates to:
 - 1) the one way system at all times on Tree Lane, Halifax proceeding in a westerly direction from a point approximately 55 metres south west of its junction with Cold Edge Road in a westerly direction to a point approximately 18 metres east of its junction with Wainstalls Road;
- (b) The Borough Council of Calderdale (On-Street Waiting, Loading And Parking Places) Order 2024 (Variation No.4) Order 2025 relates to the following restrictions:
 - 1) no vehicles shall wait, load or unload during 8.15am to 9.15am and 2.30pm to 4.00pm Mondays to Fridays in the following lengths of Wainstalls Road
 - i. on its east side from a point 16 metres south of its junction with the southern kerbline of Tree Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 49 metres;
 - ii. on its east side from a point approximately 90 metres south of its junction with the southern kerbline of Tree Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 35 metres;
 - iii. on its east side from a point approximately 138 metres south of its junction with the southern kerbline of Tree Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 13 metres;
 - 2) no vehicle shall wait or stop 8.00am 5.00pm Mondays to Fridays on the School Keep Clear Markings on the east side of Wainstalls Road from a point approximately 65 metres south of its junction with the southern kerbline of Tree Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 25 metres.

The Orders come into force on 5 May 2025. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, including the plans showing the affected roads and the statement of reasons for the Order, are available for inspection at Halifax Central Library, Halifax, HX1 1QG, from 10.00am to 5.30pm on Mondays to Fridays and 10.00am to 4.00pm on Saturdays. Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under them have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the relevant Order was made (i.e. from 30 April 2025), apply to the High Court for that purpose.
