1. **Apologies**

Assistant Director of Strategic Infrastructure was unable to attend due to another appointment.

2. **Matters arising**

3. **Previous Minutes**

TL(TE) reported that the minutes from the 26 Feb and 26 March meetings are being finalised. The minutes from the 23 April meeting have been agreed and have been published [on the website](#).

4. **Orders for Consideration**

a) Richmond Road, Halifax (TRO)

TE reported that the former highways depot on Stannary Place (formerly known as Stannary Depot) and the adjacent block of flats has been redeveloped for housing. Although it was not a specific requirement of the planning consent it was considered that changes to the parking around the site were required to maintain traffic flows and access. In addition, as the site became occupied, residents observed that uncontrolled parking was affecting access. Visits to the site showed sporadic parking issues.

In addition, an opportunity was taken to propose previously noted requirements for changes to restrictions on Richmond Road (improving traffic flow, and improving opportunities for customer parking for adjacent businesses) and Richmond Street (improving traffic flow and clarifying the restrictions around Richmond Street/Burdock Way junction). NB a separate consultation is ongoing to reduce speed limits to 20mph.

The proposals (as shown on plan A) have been consulted with emergency services etc, Ward Councillors and affected residents (via Together Housing). No responses were received.

The GB discussed the proposals and voted on whether the scheme should progress to the next stage of consultation.

Outcome

It was unanimously agreed (CL(DAM), CL(T) and CL(GSSC)) that the proposals, can proceed to statutory consultation.

The TROGB:


