Qualification-Based Learning

We offer qualifications from Entry Level 1 - Level 2. To make sure you're learning at the level that's right for you, you will complete a skills check before starting your class.

Tailored Learning

First Step - The start of your learning journey. Explore how you can build your confidence, connect with others, and learn new skills to start achieving your goals.

Next Step - Take your learning and confidence to the next stage. Delve deeper into the skills and techniques you explored in the First Step course and make informed decisions about your own progression.

To ensure courses remain accessible to everyone and support positive, sustainable outcomes, learners are encouraged to attend only the First and Next Step within the most relevant Tailored Learning area, based on their individual needs. To support fair access and meaningful progression, learners are also advised not to enrol on multiple courses across different Tailored Learning areas.

Family Learning work in partnership with many primary schools across Calderdale to provide an inclusive range of free, creative, innovative and enjoyable hands-on learning experiences.

Family Learning focusses on helping adults with parenting skills, developing an understanding of their children's needs, and improving their own skills to support their child's developments.

Activities are designed to encourage adults and children to learn together, increase parental participation and engagement with the school, enhance the children's learning at home, their health and well-being, and school readiness.





Through Family Learning, adults can reconnect with learning and transform their own lives.

Sessions include art and craft that supports literacy, numeracy and curriculum topics, parenting advice, seasonal themes, gardening and forestry projects, science and many more!

Funding and Eligibility



West | Tracy Yorkshire | Brabin Combined | Mayor of Authority | West Yorkshire All CAL courses are either fully or part funded by the government through our Adult Skills Fund (ASF) grant from the West Yorkshire Combined Authority.

The purpose of ASF funding is to support adult learners aged 19+ to gain the skills needed to enter employment, to progress within or sustain work and to access further learning or training.

To ensure funded courses are available to those who need them most, learners in receipt of specific means-tested benefits are eligible for a fee waiver (excludes Skills for Adults with Learning Disabilities courses). This means you won't have to pay course fees if any of the following apply to you...

Tailored Learning - First Step/Next Step

- ✓ In receipt of income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) or Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- √ Universal Credit (UC)*
- √ Income Support
- √ Housing Benefit
- √ Council Tax Benefit
- ✓ Pension Credit
- You are employed or self-employed and on a low wage (below the earnings threshold of £25,000 per year gross salary)

'Engage'

You are eligible for the free 'Engage' course if any of the previously listed criteria apply, or you are:

- ✓ In insecure, temporary or casual work
- ✓ Socially isolated, disadvantaged or a vulnerable adult
- ✓ A Mental Health service user and the course will benefit your health and wellbeing

Qualification-Based Courses

- Legal entitlements (English and maths up to and including Level
 2, and Digital Functional Skills to Level 1 are free)
- ✓ In receipt of an unemployment benefit (JSA/ESA/UC*) and want to be employed
- ✓ An Asylum Seeker who is eligible for funding*
- You are employed or self-employed and on a low wage (below the earnings threshold of £25,000 per year gross salary)

Co-Funding and Course Fees

If none of the above apply your course will be co-funded by the government, and you will be charged a tuition fee to contribute towards the cost of learning (fees are listed in this brochure and on the website).

For funding purposes, we must verify ID for all learners confirming your name, address and date of birth – please bring your ID to first class!

10% Discount

Everyone can claim an early enrolment discount on Term 1 courses only, when you enrol by 1 September 2025. Don't forget to tick the '10% Discount' option before making payment for your course online.
