# viii. HX 302 Locked gates at Holmfield, bottom of the Howcans bridleway

On-going issue. Obstruction keeps being removed and then comes back. Enforcement have dealt with this but needs raising again if locked again. Action – LAF members to raise if problem in future. Leave on agenda to remind people to check.

#### ix. Disabled access at Ogden Water

The main path around the reservoir was washed out during a storm meaning access is currently not possible by wheelchair users. Julie and Graham have recently discussed the possibility of putting in a temporary diversion from the car park and through the wood to join the main path close to the bridge. Graham thought this would be possible if it was well sign posted. Moy

said that Chris Sutcliffe has talked to contractors to get a cost for repairs but waiting for estimate to arrive. She said that the whole route needed resurfacing but that the work may have to be done in sections due to cost. Councillor Durrans asked if we had talked to Active Calderdale to see if they had any funding available? Moy replied that it was on her list of things to do.

Anthony said that he had spoken to Jeff Keenlyside from Green Routes, Kirklees and wondered if we should invite him to give a talk on his project to the LAF? Everyone agreed that this was a good idea. Anthony has put Jeff's email address in chat. Moy said that she would contact Jeff too.

the other at Woodroyd Gardens where a house has been built over a

claimed path by a developer. Councillor Patient said that he approves
