Introduction

The Calderdale Local Plan was adopted in March 2023, and was accompanied by a Policies Map which shows where certain Local Plan policies apply.

There are a number of designations which are made outside of the Local Plan process, but Local Plan policies apply them.

The [Adopted Policies Map](#) was amended in January 2024; a decision by Cabinet. Amendments were made to show a newly designated Conservation Area, and several new or amended Local Wildlife Sites. In addition, the Policies Map was amended to correctly label a nationally significant Historic Park and Garden. Further information on this can be viewed [here](#).

Since the Policies Map was amended in January 2024, there have been further environmental designations in Calderdale. To ensure that all customers and officers have access to all the most up to date information required when preparing or making a decision on a planning application, we have prepared an Interactive Policies Map. This map contains up to date information on new or amended designations, alongside adopted Neighbourhood Plans.

This document sets out the individual changes in the table below, and also on the maps which follow.

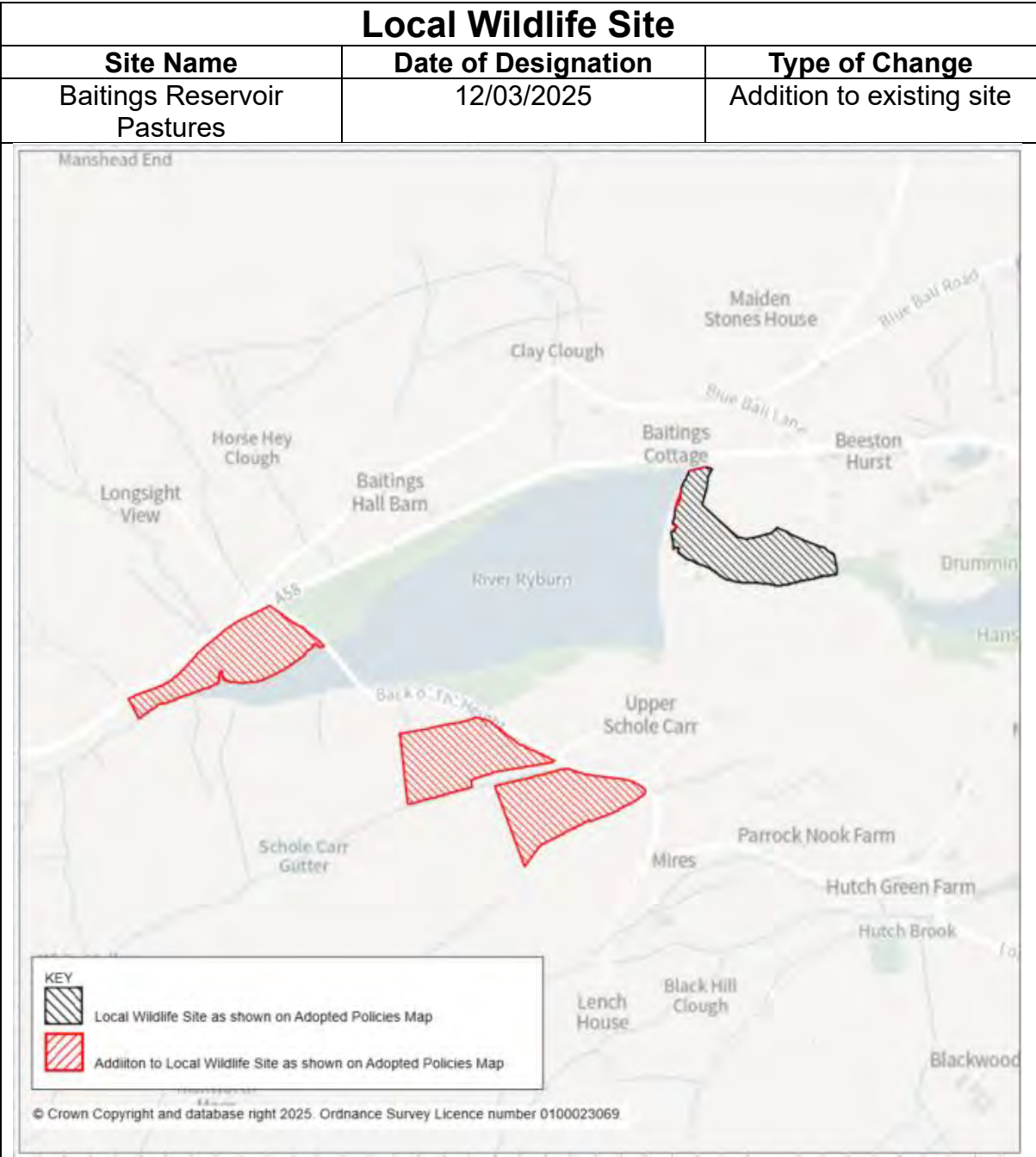

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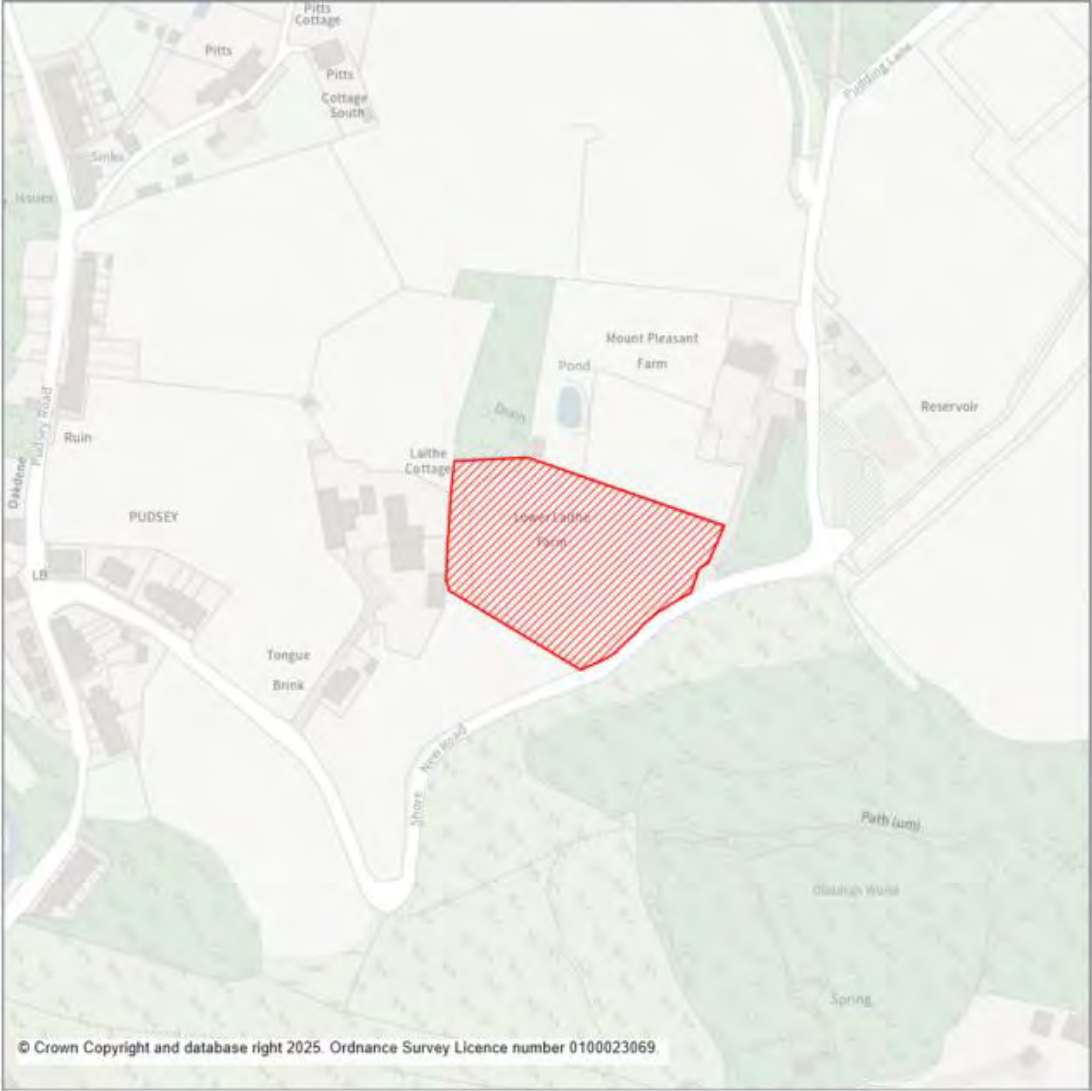
Local Wildlife Site as shown on Adopted Policies Map

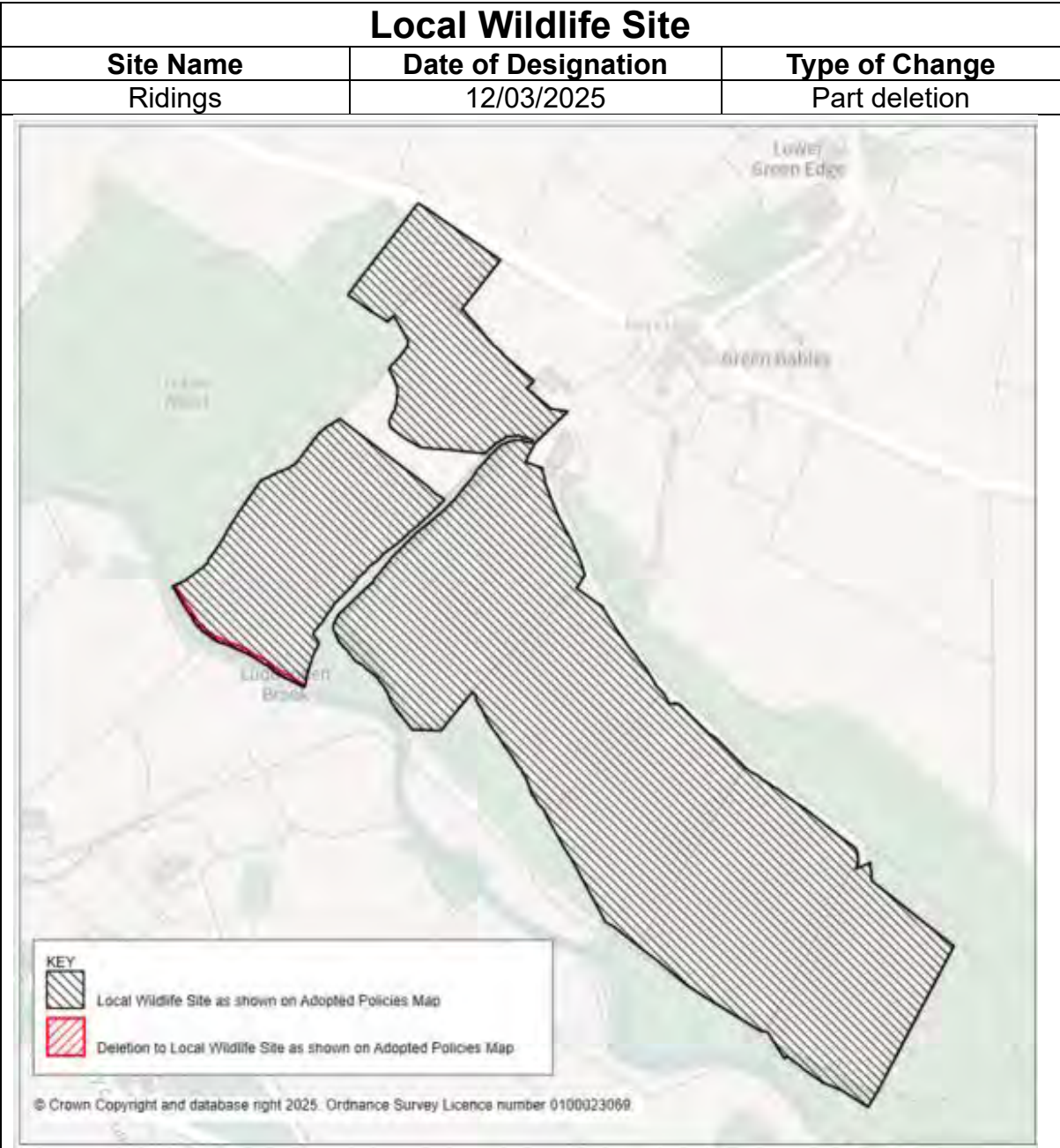
