**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

The Borough Council of Calderdale (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above Orders, the effects of which are:

(A) “The Borough Council of Calderdale (On-Street Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2024 (Variation No.\*\* ) Order 2024” will -

Introduce the following restrictions on lengths of the following roads:

Car Club parking only at all times	Alfred Street East
Limited Waiting 8am-8pm 15mins No return within 1hr	Winding Road
Loading Only 8am-8pm 30mins No return within 1hr	Causeway, Deal Street, Rawson Street
Motor cycle parking only at all times	Alfred Street East, Commercial Street
No Loading At Any Time	Alfred Street East, Blackledge, Causeway, Charles Street, Church Street, Commercial Street, Cross Street, Deal Street, Gaol Lane, Horton Street, King Street, Lister Street, New Road, Powell Street, Prescott Street, Rawson Street, South Parade, Square Road, Wade Street, Well Lane, Winding Road
No Waiting 11pm-midnight and midnight-5am Except Taxis / Disabled Badge Holders Only 5am-11pm	Commercial Street
No waiting at any time	Alfred Street East, Blackledge, Causeway, Charles Street, Church Street, Commercial Street, Cross Street, Deal Street, Gaol Lane, Horton Street, King Street, Lister Street, New Road, Powell Street, Prescott Street, Rawson Street, South Parade, Square Road (whole length inc. Pedestrian Zone), Wade Street, Well Lane, Winding Road
No Waiting 11pm-midnight and midnight-5am Except Taxis/ Payment Parking 8am-8pm Max Stay 1hr No Return Within 1hr	Commercial Street
Payment Parking 8am-8pm Max Stay 2hrs No Return Within 1hr	Rawson Street
Payment Parking 8am-8pm Max Stay 4hrs No Return Within 2hrs	Alfred Street East, Deal Street, New Road
Payment Parking 8am-8pm	Cripplegate, King Street, Mulcture Hall Road
Pedestrian Zone - No waiting at any time	Square Road

(B) “The Borough Council of Calderdale (Traffic Regulation) (Eastern Corridor, Halifax) No.1 Order 20\*\*” will introduce the following-

prohibition of driving, except for access and loading:

STREET NAME	EXTENT
Square Road	From a point approximately 5 metres north of its junction with the northern kerbline of Blackledge in a northerly direction to its junction with Alfred Street East

prohibition of driving of motor vehicles (point closure):

STREET NAME	EXTENT
New Road	From its junction with Church Street in a north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 26 metres

prescribed routes:

STREET NAME	JUNCTION WITH	PRESCRIBED DIRECTION
Causeway	Charles Street	Left turn, southerly
Prescott Street	South Parade	Left turn, northerly

one-way streets:

STREET NAME	EXTENT	DIRECTION
Blackledge	From its junction with Square Road for a distance of approximately 20 metres	Westerly
Lilly Lane	From its junction with Church Street for a distance of approximately 11 metres	Easterly
New Road	From its junction with Wellington Place to its junction with Union Street South	North-westerly
Square Road	From its junction Church Street to its junction with Alfred Street East	Northerly
Wellington Place	From its junction with Prescott Street to its junction with New Road	Northerly

- (C) "The Borough Council of Calderdale (Reserved Bus Lanes) (Halifax) Consolidation Order 2022 (Variation No. \*) Order 20\*\*\*" will -

Introduce a bus lane/gate on the following roads:

STREET NAME	EXTENT
Charles Street	a) From its junction with King Street in a southerly direction to its junction with Causeway  b) From its junction with the unnamed access road from Woolshops Shopping Centre carpark exit (adjacent to Hatters Fold) in a northerly direction to its junction with King Street

If you wish to object to or make a representation to any part of the proposed orders, you must send the grounds for your objection or support in writing to reach the Council by no later than 5<sup>th</sup> March 2026 to either ([a629phase2tro@calderdale.gov.uk](mailto:a629phase2tro@calderdale.gov.uk)) or to Highways and Transportation, C/O the Town Hall, Crossley Street, Halifax, HX1 1UJ for the attention of the Highways Traffic Team. All objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
